attractions in the country. It includes a behind-the scenes tour of the film sets and props used in the making of the movies. Lovers of green space are served well by Leavesden Country Park, which offers more than 27 hectares to explore, including a football pitch, tennis courts, a kids' play area and an outdoor gym for adults.
